**1. CLARIFICATIONS:**

1.	Contractors shall assume rock will be encountered and that breakers will be required. Backfill in areas with rock will require import soils. Rocky material will not be permitted for backfill. Contractor shall be responsible for exporting and legally disposing of native rocky soils.
2.	Contractor will be required to provide a Caltrans approved Portable Changeable Message Sign with an alternate route message per Caltrans requirements throughout the duration of construction.
3.	Contractor will be required to provide a pilot car escort as part of their traffic control measures throughout the duration of construction. Provide a separate cost line item, as this requirement may be waived after Caltrans reviews the final Traffic Control Plan.

B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

    - a. Measurement for Bid Item No. 1.01 shall be based on completion of such work as a lump sum.
  2. Payment
    - a. Payment for Bid Item No. 1.01 shall be made at the lump sum price stated in the Bid Form. The lump sum price shall contain all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the Work for the Main listed in the Bid Item in accordance with the Drawings and Specifications. The Work includes, but is not limited to, the following:
      - 1) Mobilization and demobilization associated with construction of the Main listed in the Bid Item.
      - 2) Potholing crossings and connection points (including cultural test holes if noted on Drawings) for the Main listed in the Bid Item prior to construction and in accordance with Section 02 01 20 and the Drawings.
      - 3) Stormwater pollution prevention measures for the Main listed in the Bid Item in accordance with Section 01 57 23. This includes, but is not limited to:
        - (a) All costs associated with the Main listed in the Bid Item for preparing the stormwater pollution prevention plan (SWPPP), rain event action plan (REAP), compliance reports and any other permit registration documents (PRDs) for DWP's approval and the submission of the documents to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) via SMARTS;
        - (b) All costs associated with the Main listed in the Bid Item for implementation of the SWPPP and coordination with DWP for DWP's compliance reporting, including the installation, maintenance, and removal of erosion control practices specified in the SWPPP upon completion of the Project such that it satisfies all criteria necessary to achieve a Notice of Termination or as requested by DWP.

Contractor shall supply detailed sheeting, shoring, and bracing plans, prepared by a licensed Civil or Structural Engineer, as required.
